# **2021 KEY DATES AHEAD**

## **SEPTEMBER**

*TAFE Applications 2022:* usually goes `live' for online applications mid-September and is available usually until the beginning of December. Enrolment occurs in January for Semester One, 2022.

#### 9<sup>th</sup> September

ATAR Examinations: Students are to download and print their personalised practical and written examination timetables via the Authority's student portal at <u>Student portal (scsa.wa.edu.au)</u>. It is important that students check the start time and place for their exam the night before their exam and reprint personalised timetable if necessary. Personalised timetables must be taken to each exam along with identification (ie driver's license).

# 17th September (Friday Week 9 Term 3)

All VET Certificate Qualifications units of competency <u>must be completed</u> to allow finalisation of marking and re-submission for final sign-off as competent by the assessor by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> September.

#### 23<sup>rd</sup> September (Thursday Week 10 Term 3)

ATAR students will receive their personalised timetables for the Mock Examinations. These <u>must</u> be taken to each of their Examinations along with identification. These timetables are not available from the SCSA portal as they are school-based examinations. The entire examination timetable can be found on the College Website along with the Examination Protocols - <u>Senior School | Halls Head College (hallsheadcc.wa.edu.au)</u>.

## 24<sup>th</sup> September (Friday Week 10 Term 3)

All ATAR course assessed work to be completed by Friday Week 10, Term 3 - the exception being the ATAR Mock Examinations.

This is the last day for General/Foundation WACE course work to be submitted for final assessment.

*Clearance forms* need to be signed off and returned to Student Services. All borrowed items: books, calculators, etc. need to be returned and <u>fees must be paid.</u>

**Note:** There is an exception for ATAR students who must return borrowed items following External Examinations at the end of November.

## 29<sup>th</sup> September – 04<sup>th</sup> October (these exams will include weekends and public holidays)

Physical Education Studies Practical Exams: these exams are scheduled by each student's chosen sport. Students are to print their personalised practical examination timetable from the student portal at <a href="Student portal">Student portal (scsa.wa.edu.au)</a>. Students must take their personalised timetable to their practical exams along with identification. Students must check their time and venue the night before their exam.

#### **OCTOBER**

## 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> October (Week 2 Term 3 holidays)

ATAR Mock Written Examinations will be scheduled on site at Halls Head College for the second week of the school holidays. These examinations will occur in Block 5. The examinations will mirror as closely as possible what the students can expect for their ATAR External Written Examinations with outside invigilators and strict exam protocols enforced.

## 15<sup>th</sup> October (last day for Year 12 General students)

Year 12 Dress-up Day.

Year 12 Leavers' Breakfast: students are to arrive at school for a 7:45 start. A schedule for the day including Valedictory practice, presentations by external agencies preparing students for Leavers and adulthood and a final farewell procession has been planned.

Farewell Procession commencing in the Gym at 12.30pm. All Year 12 students will finish school for the day at the completion of the Farewell Procession. If you do not wish for your child to leave at this time, please respond to this email and inform the school.

**15<sup>th</sup> October:** Final date for purchasing Valedictory Tickets. Tickets can be purchased through the Accounts Office in the Administration. Student Ticket package costs \$120. This includes two adult tickets. For additional Adult Tickets the cost is \$30, and \$15 for Concession and Children (under 15 years).

Information about the Valedictory Ceremony has been handed out to students but you will have a copy with this document. Both will be posted on CONNECT.

#### 22<sup>nd</sup> October

This is the last day for Year 12 ATAR Students.

#### 28th October

**Valedictory Ceremony:** Students are to arrive from **4.30pm** but no later than **5pm**. Attire for this event is `semi-formal dress code' with clothing being in **black and white only** (no denim, thongs, low cut dresses or blouses, mini-skirts or mini-dresses).

Parents, relatives, and friends need to arrive <u>with their tickets</u> (available for purchase from Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021) and should be seated for the commencement of the ceremony at 7pm.

#### 29th October

Last day for student appeals against school results for courses studied in Year 12.

#### **NOVEMBER**

#### 01<sup>st</sup> November

ATAR External Written Examinations commence on 1st November and will conclude 19th November. The written timetables are available online in the SCSA website: 2021 ATAR Course Written Examinations Timetable and our College Website: ATAR Examination Timetable – Written (2021).

ATAR External Written Examinations will occur in Block 5 at Halls Head College.

It is essential that every ATAR student checks and ensures that their Student Portal information is all correct. In the unlikely event of a COVID lockdown these exams will still be prioritised but contacts need to be accurate if changes take place so that notification can be given. Please check the Student's CONNECT page for an outline of what needs to happen. Personalised exam timetables may need to be updated in the student portal if this happens and students will need to check this regularly if a COVID scenario unfolds. If a lockdown is in play students must wear masks to exams. Additional masks will be available from the Invigilator if required. Additional hand sanitiser and cleaning will be in play regardless of COVID requirements.
